- Joy of Discovery is making an impact on the Raleigh Community

Directions:

- If driving east on the 440 inner belt line, (pass New Bern Ave. and Rocky Mount). Take exit #15 Poole Rd. Turn right and follow directions above.

- If you live in or are familiar with Southeast Raleigh, we are near the Kroger grocery store and Martin Luther King Blvd. Stay to the right on Martin Luther King Blvd. It becomes Poole Rd. Turn right on King Richard Rd. Drive to the end and enter through the open gate to building 750. See sign "Joy Of Discovery Lutheran Church".
